 - The books starts at 20 pages and you can add pages for a small additional fee. It has to be an even number of pages.
 - It can be sold at any price point. You set the price

7. PAC questions of the month

- For the Stakeholder meeting what Question that we can bring up what is working, positive and negative
 - o Do we see a difference with increase number of teachers?
 - i. It is nicer that there is not as many students in the schools and students are not getting lost. Teacher can give the students more time/more help.
 - ii. There seems to be a lot more split classes
 - o There is still a struggle with the EA numbers.
 - i. The part time REAP program graduation will be this week.
 - ii. This is the third class that has graduated and the district has hired most of them (a few are being hired in other districts).
 - iii. There are two more classes starting, a part time and a full time. The part time class starts in February it takes 1 year to complete. The full time class there is an information session on February 3rd at the board office.
 - iv. After three grad classes the district is still 40 EAs' short.
 - Emergency preparedness
 - o Education needs to be a priority with the City councilors. The trustees need to make sure that we are first.
 - i. School Superintendent Conference, Canada is the top for a great education system, BC is a high province, and the Richmond is high as a city.
 - ii. Our students are also doing well, mentally and well in school. We need to work hard to protect it.
 - Curriculum will be implemented for September 2018 for Grade 10 and then Grand 11 and 12 the year after September 2019.



- i. Included will be collaboration time once a month students arrives 1 hour later, the Teachers meet to see what is working and coordinate with other departments within the school.
- o MLA meeting at the end of the month Emergency Preparedness and funding process model will be the two discussion topics.
 - i. Funding model the soonest that the government will look at making any changes is 2019.
